### **US STUDIES CENTRE HEAD TO GIVE LIVE TV COMMENTARY ON US PRESIDENTIAL DEBATES**

The United States Studies Centre's Professor Geoffrey Garrett will be a commentator on national television coverage of the upcoming US presidential debates.

Professor Garrett is the founding chief executive of the United States Studies Centre at The University of Sydney.

He was previously President of the Pacific Council on International Policy, where he remains Senior Fellow, and Professor of International Relations, Business Administration, Communication and Law at the University of Southern California.

Among the most widely cited political scientists of his generation, Professor Garrett is an expert on American politics and foreign policy, the causes and consequences of globalisation and the impact of China's rise on the US.
