Dale Howes has been recently been appointed Associate Professor, School of Dentistry, Faculty of Medicine and Health, at the University of Sydney, Australia. He was previously in full time private practice with part time appointment as adjunct professor in the department oral rehabilitation University of the Witwatersrand before taking over as the Professor and head of that department.

He is the immediate past president of the ISMR (International Society for Maxillofacial Rehabilitation), board member and treasurer of the ICP (International College of Prosthodontists), was an invited fellow of the International academy for Oral and Facial Rehabilitation (IAOFR) and served on the North American working group for Advanced Digital Technology in Craniofacial Reconstruction.

He has received peer review fellowships from the Colleges of Medicine of South Africa and the International College of Dentists serving as the regional Vice Regent. He is a past president of the Academy of Prosthodontics of South Africa, and founder member of the P-I Brånemark Institute of South Africa as well as the Face Value Foundation Trust, a Public Benefit Organisation. This PBO is dedicated to enhancing head and neck treatment and rehabilitation through comprehensive multidisciplinary care, research and education. He also started the Head and Neck support Group for cancer patients.

He was also awarded the Premier Award of the South African Dental Association (2016) and the I.Y. Sendulskogo Commemorative Medal of the Russian Partnership of Head and Neck Oncology Specialists for outstanding achievements in medicine. (2015). He has Awarded Best Presentations at the Nobel Biocare World Congress 2005 and the Academy of Osseointegration Boston 2008.

He has supervised Masters and PhD projects, been external examiner nationally and internationally as well as publishing research and book chapters in fields including head and neck cancer rehabilitation, occlusion and biomechanics.

I was appointed to this academic position after over 20 years of full-time practice and part-time postgraduate teaching, research and involvement in the University and the Department. I sold my practice but continued active involvement and part time practice.

The Department of Oral Rehabilitation consisted of the Divisions of Operative Dentistry, Endodontics and Fixed and Removable Prosthodontics;

This made it possible for vertical and horizontal integration in the teaching between these disciplines toward the goal of integrated patient centred dental care and teaching.

The department staff compliment included 3 Heads of Clinical Units as senior prosthodontists, 3 additional full time prosthodontists and 9 general dental practitioners to manage the teaching and research load.

In addition I appointed a number of additional part time specialists and generalists to add private practice input to the students, in particular the senior general dental students and post graduates.

As Head of Department, my responsibilities and developments briefly explained:

- The coordination and delivery of 14 undergraduate courses in a five-year undergraduate programme for General Dentistry. I maintained hands on supervision and hands on training for general dental programme including enodontics.
- 6 specialist Masters post graduate courses including research techniques and research report in a four year programme.
- Coordination of MSc programmes in all divisions within the department including a research programme.
- The full spectrum of personnel, equipment, materials and academic supervision of these multiple needs and divisions.
- Management of Laboratory processes and skills transfer.
- Procurement of 5-axis CAD CAM technology and skills development.
- Co-ordination and commissioning of a new multidisciplinary polyclinic within the hospital.
- Enhanced the multidisciplinary dental implant clinic between prosthodontics, periodontics and maxillofacial and oral surgery I developed previously as a part-time supervisor in the department.
- Developed the dental neuroscience clinic aimed at the management of craniomandibular disorders, sleep medicine and pain clinic.
- Development of a multidisciplinary head and neck clinic with the disciplines of medicine including ENT; Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Radiation Oncology as well as speech and language pathology, dietetics, physiotherapy and psychology.

The clinic aims and objectives were to coordinate head and neck oncology and trauma management to improve functional outcomes.

- I have developed working relationships with the medical disciplines in the departments of surgery and neurosciences.
- I have developed working relationships with other faculties including mechanical and mechatronics engineering
- I have developed better public private relationships to enhance the training and service delivery in a financially constrained environment for students and patients.
  - In addition, developed an early detection outreach programme and support group for head and neck cancer sufferers with the Face Value Foundation.

Late in 2016, the provincial structure changed to separate the divisions of prosthodontics from operative dentistry and endodontics to include paediatric dentistry.

A major contribution to the undergraduate curriculum was to modify the presentation and teaching of preclinical operative dentistry, orthodontics and removable prosthodontics is now taught in first and second year of study. Rationalisation of basic subjects including physics, biochemistry and physiology. This has given more time for clinical teaching in third fourth and fifth years of study.

After research collaboration, I was invited by Professor P-I Brånemark to develop the second P-I Brånemark Institute in the world with the objectives of responsible training, research and treatment of indigent patients with osseointegration.

This was achieved after fund raising and partnerships with MediClinic.

We have since developed an international training programme in advanced dental implantology and framework agreements with the Faculty of Health Sciences and the Department of Health to serve as satellite clinic training centre for post graduate students.

With the Institute and international collaboration I brought the concepts of advanced digital technology and rapid prototyping in functional craniofacial rehabilitation to South Africa obtaining one of the first prototyping units dedicated to advanced digital technology for head and neck rehabilitation. In 2011 I arranged and hosted the first hands on functional prefabricated fibula course in South Africa in collaboration with the International Society for Maxillofacial Rehabilitation and the University of Alberta, Canada.

I was instrumental in the development of a public-private multidisciplinary head and neck forum at the institute consisting of 36 medical, dental and allied professionals and disciplines focussed on the patient centred care of head and neck cancer.

This unit is being developed into the first integrated professional unit within the Morningside Mediclinic hospital.

With the services to the teaching and research I was promoted as a part time specialist in the School to Adjunct Professor.

My duties continued as clinical coordinator of post graduate prosthodontic training.
