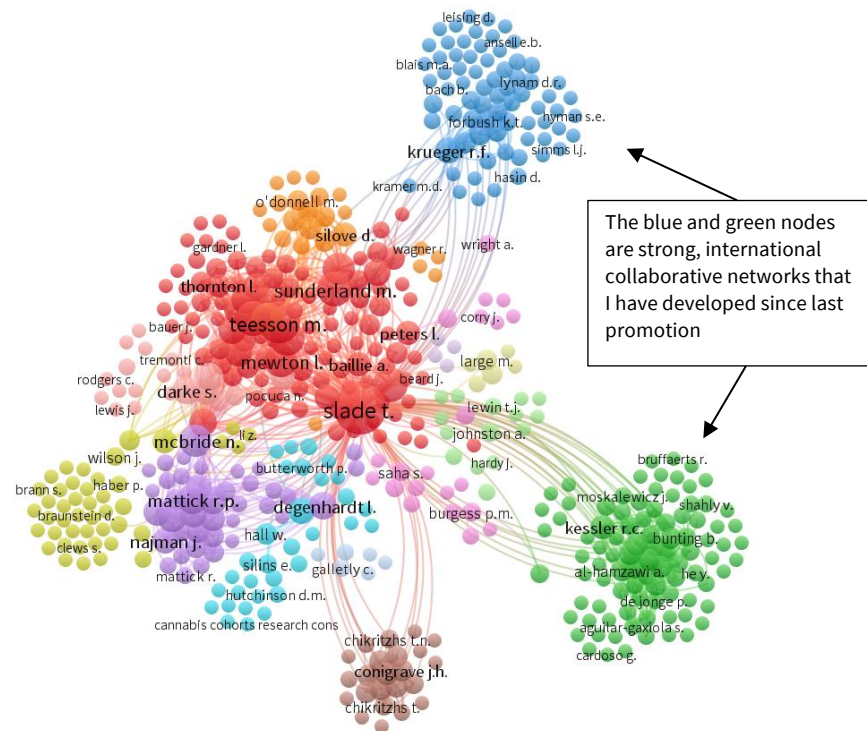

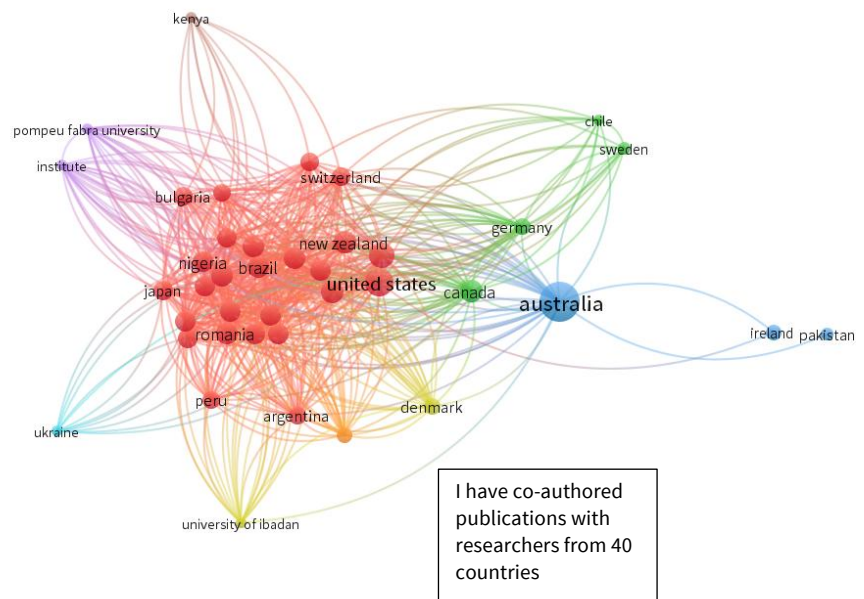

1. Dr Matthew Sunderland

Thesis title: Design and validation of a short form structured diagnostic interview for psychiatric disorders: the MINI-CIDI 3.0)

Key achievements:

- I have supervised and mentored Dr Sunderland for the past 10 years. He received multiple awards for his PhD research including the UNSW Faculty of Medicine Dean's Rising Star Award (2011) and the Society for Mental Health Research Rising Star Award (2017)
- After his PhD Dr Sunderland successfully secured a competitive NHMRC Early Career Fellowship
- Dr Sunderland was promoted to Level C in 2016 (currently under consideration for promotion to Level D)
- Dr Sunderland has published 103 journal articles and has secured NHMRC project grant funding as CIA (\$380K)

2. Dr Louise Mewton

Thesis title: The classification of substance use disorders in young adults

Current Position: Senior Research Scientia Fellow, Centre for Health Brain Ageing, University of New South Wales

Key achievements:

- Dr Mewton was awarded an NDARC UNSW PhD scholarship to examine the diagnosis of alcohol use disorders in young adults, a highly topical area of research at the time
- Dr Mewton's PhD work directly informed the way alcohol use disorders are diagnosed in the international classification system (DSM) gaining worldwide media attention (e.g. New York Times)
- Dr Mewton went on to secure a highly competitive UNSW Scientia Fellowship has gone on to publish 67 journal articles and has received competitive research grant funding, including \$598K as CIA
