

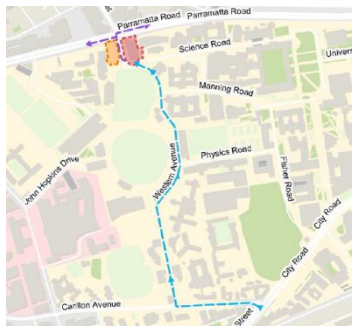
A01 – LEARNING AND TEACHING HUB CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

FDC Construction is proud to be delivering the A01 Teaching and Learning Building as Head Contractor, a landmark project supporting the University's three key strategic priorities. Through new and improved teaching and learning spaces, the development enhances the student experience by enabling transformational education, creates places that work better for the entire University community, and integrates physical and digital infrastructure in support of the Digital Sydney initiative — positioning A01 as a benchmark for modern, connected learning environments.

PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR IMPACTS

The A01 construction site is located at the northern edge of the University of Sydney's Camperdown Campus, immediately south of Parramatta Road and adjacent to the Ross Street Gates. Key changes to be taken note of:

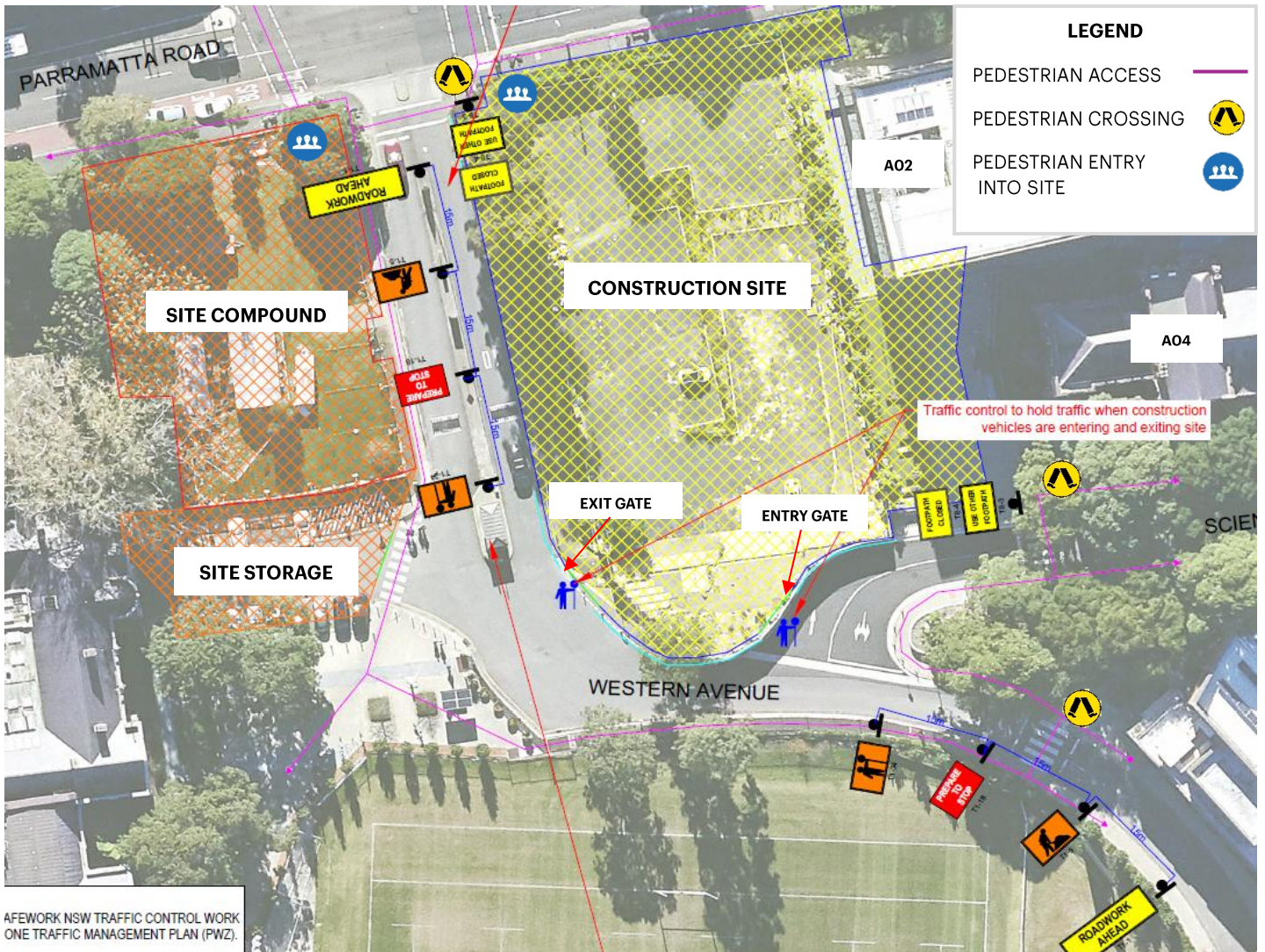
- Western Avenue will generally remain open to two-way traffic and will continue to operate as a 10 km/h shared zone during the Stage 1 works. However, due to the constrained road width and the turning space required by heavy vehicles, traffic controllers may temporarily hold vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists while construction vehicles enter or leave the site.
- No construction vehicle access from Parramatta Road to the site. Vehicles will enter and exit site entry gates from Western Avenue.
- JD Stewart car park will be closed during the duration of the project.
- The eastern footpath along Western Avenue, adjacent to the principal construction site will remain closed and the pedestrians will continue to use the western side of Western Avenue

SPECIFICS:

- A-Class hoarding installation around the construction site and site compound and Temporary Fencing installation around JD Stewart Car park.
- Road closure scheduled for 05th September 2026 (inbound traffic from Paramatta Road) to relocate the hoarding along Western Ave eastern side.
- Delivery of site sheds into the site compound
- Heritage Fence removal along the northern side may create some disruption to pedestrian movement.
- Fencing installation along the eastern side of the existing site hoarding and the A02 & A04 buildings may create some disruption to pedestrian movement.
- Commencement of main excavation works on site.
- Neighbours will be notified ahead of specific out of hour deliveries.
