



A01 – LEARNING AND TEACHING HUB

The A01 Teaching & Learning Hub is a new building providing formal teaching spaces in a large, flat-floor format that enables flexible, collaborative, and larger-scale teaching. The building also delivers much-needed informal learning space to enhance the student experience, along with a food and beverage outlet, a micro market, and student amenities.

Fronting Parramatta Road, Science Road, and Western Avenue on the Camperdown Campus, the project improves student experience and pedestrian safety while creating a revitalised gateway to the campus, building on the long-established pathways used by the Gadigal people along Parramatta Road.

It will be located in the north-west portion of the Camperdown Campus. The site is bounded by Parramatta Road to the north, the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASS) Building and R. D. Watt Building to the east, Western Avenue to the west (also referred to as Ross Street) and Science Road to the south.

The A01 Ross St will comprise of 5 levels incorporating teaching and learning spaces for general use by all faculties across the University to improve the student experience across the campus. The development also includes public domain works, traffic and pedestrian access improvements and landscaping around the new building.
