You are invited to submit a poster presentation of innovative research in brain and mind sciences.

Due to the virtual format of this year's symposium, all posters which meet the criteria listed below will be displayed across the Mallett St Campus throughout December and will be uploaded online. The top scoring posters in each category will be invited to do a brief recorded oral presentation of their poster which will be uploaded as supplementary content of the Symposium.

Prizes will be given for the best posters in the following categories:

- 1. Honours
- 2. HDR
- 3. Early-career (<10 years post-PhD, <academic level C).

Posters should:

- Be a single 16:9 landscape PDF or PowerPoint slide
- Include authors, introduction, methods, results, discussion, conclusion and references
- As posters will be uploaded online, ensure any hyperlinks work correctly

Posters will be judged according to:

- Clarity of aims and objectives
- Adequacy of methods and data analysis
- Appropriate interpretation of findings
- Originality and potential impact of research
- Visual impact and flow of content
- Referencing
