

Project/Placement Participation for Students

University of Business School Industry Placement Program

Credited towards a Business School degree, the Industry Placement Program (IPP) offers a work placement for a minimum of three days per week for 10 weeks during semester or an equivalent number of hours over the summer vacation programs.

External project as part of a Capstone Unit of Study

ITLS works with its industry partners to match a student's Unit of Study project with a relevant company/organisation. Interested industry partners are encouraged to contact ITLS and register the project areas they are interested in and these will be disseminated to our students via lecturers in charge. Interested students will provide ITLS with an up-to-date copy of their CV which will then be forwarded on to the relevant partner.

Non-credit Unpaid Work Experience

A student can undertake unpaid work experience whilst enrolled in a University of Sydney degree for up to a period of 24 days. How those days are allocated is negotiated between the industry partner and student. Students must complete an appropriate insurance form before commencing work experience.

Work experience Jobs Board – advertise free of charge

ITLS will advertise free of charge for any industry partner seeking students to undertake work experience in the post-completion, pre-graduation (approximately three months). ITLS will advise all students in their last semester of study about current employment opportunities via a fortnightly newsletter which will provide details on each position. ITLS has no further involvement. The recruitment process, insurance, salaries and so forth are arranged directly between the industry partner and the student.
