The ITAS Platform is a custom-designed web-based platform for automating the administration of the Indigenous Tutorial Assistance Scheme-Tertiary Tuition (ITAS-TT), a government funded tutorial study support for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students attending Australian universities.

Technology

TAS Platform provides:

- End-to-end process management,
- A simple, but powerful user interface for students, tutors and program coordinators,
- Collection of engagement data, intervention and action points,
- Automated reporting for program coordinators with tailored dashboards.

How it works

Students and tutors provide expressions of interest through a web portal. Advanced, data-driven machine-learning algorithms match students with tutors with consideration to factors such as expertise, interest, credentials, availability, and other preferences. Coordinators can also override the automation to directly match students to tutors. The platform is used for bookings and to monitor prescribed hours as per the ITAS-TT requirements, with validation to allow for timely intervention. The platform includes Help and FAQ sections with videos and error reporting functions.

The platform needs minimal customisation to be deployed and can be ready for your next semester. It is also adaptable to other tuition programs.
