Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Focused Initiatives in Social Work and Education Conference 2026

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Identify as an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person
- Be aged 18 years or over at the time of the conference
- Demonstrate a clear connection between their attendance and: Community benefit, professional development, study, research, or advocacy; and/or contribution to First Nations peoples, communities, or organisations
- Be able to attend the conference in full (or as specified) on the days indicated

What the Scholarship covers

- Conference registration fees

Recipient Responsibilities

Successful scholarship recipients agree to:

- Attend the conference as outlined in the acceptance letter
- Notify organisers as early as possible if circumstances change
- Participate respectfully in line with the conference's cultural safety and code of conduct principles

The conference recognises the diversity of First Nations peoples, cultures, and experiences. All processes are guided by principles of self-determination, respect, and cultural safety.
