### IT requirements

Applicants must attend online using a laptop/desktop computer with camera and microphone.

To optimise your Assessment Day experience, please follow the recommendations below:

- Download the latest version of Zoom from [zoom.us](https://zoom.us) (on computer) or App Store (on Apple devices) or Google Play store (Android devices).
- Use a wired internet connection for consistency of connection. If you do not have a wired connection, ensure that your wireless connection is reliable enough to complete the assessment process.
- Test the speed of your connection at <http://www.speedtest.net/>. For good connections, we recommend 1 Mbps (megabit per second) as a bare minimum with 4 Mbps as a preferred minimum speed.
- Use a headset with a microphone for clarity.
- Test your microphone and speakers prior to the day.
