

INFORMATION ON ONLINE ASSESSMENT DAY (FRIDAY 21 JANUARY 2022) FOR ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Due to the delayed ATAR release this year, there will be a tighter than usual time frame for the University to conduct the Double Degree Medicine Program (DDMP) and the Double Degree Dentistry Program (DDDP) assessment. The University would like to provide some general information to ensure eligible applicants are equipped to meet the timeline and understand the IT requirements needed on Assessment Day. Applicants should rely on the official invitation sent on 20 January 2022 for the final details, including what to expect and what to have ready on the Day.

Timeline for invites

- Applicants who achieve the required ATAR results (or equivalent) will receive an invitation email from fmh.recruitment@sydney.edu.au to attend the online Assessment Day soon after ATAR results release at 9am on Thursday 20 January 2022 (as per UAC Timeline).
- If you wish to accept the invitation, you must RSVP your attendance by 2pm on Thursday 20 January 2022 as instructed in the invitation email.
- After receipt of your RSVP and after 2pm, you will be provided with further information via email including the Zoom link to be used for the Assessment Day on Friday 21 January 2022. Please expect to receive this email after 3pm.
- If you do not receive the email with Zoom link by 4pm on Thursday 20 January 2022, please contact medicine.ugapplication@sydney.edu.au (for this purpose ONLY, no other emails will be responded to) immediately. Please note this email account will not be monitored after Close of Business at 5pm.

All dates and times listed are Sydney, Australia time and are subject to change depending on the UAC schedule.

Note: Please check all mailboxes including the junk mailbox regularly for any correspondence from the University. It is the responsibility of the applicant to check their accounts; the University will not be held responsible for any unread email communication or for any resulting delays or disadvantage.

If you fail to RSVP by the deadline, your application for the Double Degree Medicine Program and/or Double Degree Dentistry Program for 2022 entry will be deemed to have lapsed and will not be considered further.

What to prepare for the day

Eligible applicants will need access to a laptop/desktop computer with camera and microphone for the Assessment Day.

Assessment Day will be conducted via Zoom. Please see below tips that will help improve your assessment experience and minimise technical problems:

- Download the latest version of Zoom from zoom.us (on computer) or App Store (on Apple devices) or Google Play store (Android devices).
- Use a wired internet connection for consistency of connection. If you do not have a wired connection, ensure that your wireless connection is reliable enough to complete the assessment process.
- Test the speed of your connection at <http://www.speedtest.net/>. For good connections, we recommend 1 Mbps (megabit per second) as a bare minimum with 4 Mbps as a preferred minimum speed.
- Use a headset with a microphone for clarity.
- Test your microphone and speakers prior to the day.
