Transfer

Transfer of enrolment between dental schools is not possible, other than in exceptional circumstances. Applications for transfer to the DMD close on 30 September prior to the commencement year.

Transfer will not be considered if an applicant has previously applied unsuccessfully for admission to the DMD.

Applicants for transfer must have met the requirements for admission to the DMD that were in place at the time of admission to their current dental school.

Applicants for transfer must complete at least 50 per cent of the DMD at the University of Sydney (ie transfers will only be considered for entry into Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3).

Matters that the Head of School and Dean will take into account when considering an application for transfer include:

- 1. The circumstances leading to a request for transfer;
- 2. Whether the dental program curriculum undertaken by the applicant at the current institution is comparable to the DMD, as determined by the Sydney Dental School;
- 3. The applicant's academic performance in the current dental program; and
- 4. The availability of places in the year applied for.

Applicants for transfer may be required to undertake a barrier examination to demonstrate the necessary capabilities for entry into the appropriate year of the DMD.

Applicants will be required to consent to the release of all documents relevant to their current course.
