## The Human Health and Social Impacts Node

The Human Health and Social Impacts (HHSI) Node of the NSW Adaptation Research Hub is a collaboration between The University of Sydney, other leading universities and experts in climate change impacts and adaptation science, which is funded by the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) and NSW Health. The work program of the Node is informed by the eco-social understandings of relationships between climate change and health. The approach taken acknowledges the range of environmental, social and economic consequences of climate change, including regional variation in impacts and vulnerability.

Building on current sources of health and climate change information, the Node will support the NSW Government by:

1. delivering robust, sector specific information targeting the health system, vulnerable communities and government agencies,
2. establishing baselines for monitoring, evaluation and analysis of adaptation programs that seek to protect and promote health, and strengthen the delivery of health services, in the face of a changing climate
3. improving understanding of vulnerability in the context of exposure, sensitivity and adaptive capacity, and
4. providing practical information on building resilience in communities and the health sector.

The HHSI Node has brought together more than 40 researchers representing the NSW DPIE, NSW Health, the University of Sydney and other collaborating universities, as well as councils and local health districts.

## Showcase Aims

This online meeting will highlight the HHSI Node successes to date and extend collaborations among climate and health researchers at the University of Sydney and beyond.

The objectives of the Showcase are to:

1. Share the wealth of knowledge and impact generated by the HHSI Node researchers and others to date.
