- 300 words maximum (not including title and co-authors)
- Co-authors: please include first names, last names and their affiliations

- Extended: Abstract submissions close Sunday 9 October, 2022, 11.59pm
- Outcome of abstract review notification Monday 31 October

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible the abstracts must be on medical and health research and the presenter must be an early or mid-career researcher (EMCR) from the University of Sydney (staff and affiliates). For the purposes of this opportunity, EMCR (with allowance for career disruption) is defined as:

- Early career researcher (0-10 years post-PhD)
- Mid-career researcher (10-15 years post-PhD)

ABSTRACT REVIEW

As the focus of the 2022 EMCR Showcase is on the <u>FMH Networks</u>, priority will be given to presentations that align with one or more of the Networks.

The panels reviewing the abstracts will mark them on the following criteria:

Appeal

- 1 Appealing and informative title
- 2 Style of writing is clear and of high quality
- 3 Will capture the interest of a wide audience

Scientific quality

- 1 Methods are appropriate and explained clearly
- 2 Design of the study/method is appropriate to answer the aims of the abstract
- 3 Results are supported by data obtained/intended analyses are consistent with aim/s

Significance

- 1 Potential for significant health impact, and/or to fill a gap in knowledge
- 2 The abstract indicates the value of the findings and to whom will they be of use

Please note that following the review, feedback on individual submissions may not be available.

- Are students eligible to submit an abstract? No, this abstract submission opportunity is specifically for early and mid-career researchers as defined above.
- Can co-authors be a student and/ or affiliated with an institution or organisation other than the University of Sydney Yes.
- Can I include diagrams, graphs etc in my abstract? No, your abstract will need to be submitted online entered into a text box, so only text is accepted.
- Do I need to/can I include references? Please do not include references as part of your 300-word abstract submission.
- What if my abstract does not align with any of the FMH Networks, can I still submit an abstract? Yes, please submit your abstract as there will be presentation opportunities, in poster format and possibly oral presentations.
