## Clinical Ethics Discussion Group

(Open to SESLHD staff only)

## Clinical Ethics Forum

## Clinical Ethics Roundtable

The Clinical Ethics Roundtable (formerly “Masterclass”) sessions create some more room for ethics reflection and skill development. These online sessions bring together people interested in clinical and academic ethics to explore ethical topics from the clinical sphere in conjunction with related literature. Roundtable is an informal and collegiate space to explore practical clinical ethics issues in greater depth and in conversation with clinicians, academics, and others. There will be speakers to briefly introduce some cases or topics, but the aim of Roundtable is to provide an opportunity for discussions and reflection among attendees. SESLHD alternates hosting of the Roundtable with the clinical ethics team at the Sydney Children’s Hospital Network.

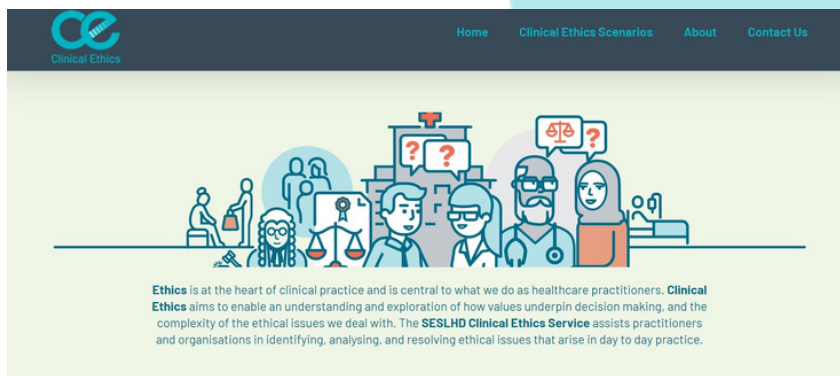
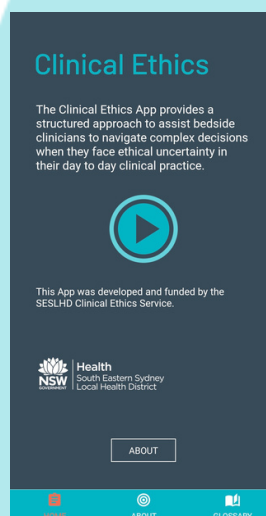
## Clinical Ethics Salon
