



The University of Sydney School of Health Sciences Student Leadership Award

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. The University of Sydney School of Health Sciences Student Leadership Award is awarded to students who have demonstrated sustained and outstanding student leadership while studying a course or major offered by the Sydney School of Health Sciences, Faculty of Medicine and Health at the University of Sydney.
- b. This Prize is funded by the Sydney School of Health Sciences.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Applicants must be enrolled in a course or major of the School of Health Sciences, University of Sydney at the time of their application.
- b. Applicants must have engaged in leadership activities that further the goals and values of The University of Sydney in their discipline or profession and/or on a health-related community issue.
- c. Applicants may nominate themselves or be nominated by a peer or academic staff member of the University of Sydney.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded based on prior academic merit and evidence provided of leadership activities and impact.

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value of \$1,000 and will be paid as a one-off payment.
- b. No other amount is payable.
- c. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing Eligibility

- a. None apply.

6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct or professionalism breach, including, but not limited



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to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.

- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated.

7. Other Requirements

- a. Successful recipients will be invited to address future student groups and engage in alumni activities.
- b. Successful recipients must be willing to be profiled in Faculty and University publications and websites and to share their experiences with current students and staff.
