This workshop will explore the research potential of the proposed National Hybrid Particle Therapy Facility dedicated research room. We'll discuss research opportunities, funding models, and infrastructure needs. This workshop is open to both clinical and research teams.

This community discussion will kickstart the roadmap towards a unified vision for a national particle therapy facility with a dedicated research room for non-clinical applications, and a sustainable operating model that meets Australia's needs. There will be a series of fast-paced presentations from potential users of the facility, and information from national and international facilities that have developed broad spectrum research, with time for connection and collaboration during session breaks.
