## **CVE Credit towards courses:**

In recognition of veterinary practices who host our students as part of our PiVE Program, the CVE credit works on a retrospective basis with practices able to redeem credit towards CVE programs and courses the year after they have hosted a student/s (CVE Credit).

 Credit towards CVE courses must be redeemed within a 24 month period from date of issue. CVE is unable to extend CVE Credit beyond the expiry date. Expired credit cannot be used for any courses or purchases or otherwise redeemed.

- If upon redeeming your CVE Credit, the cost payable for the selected courses exceeds the CVE Credit value, you will need to pay the difference.
