

NHMRC Postgraduate Scholarships 2025 Submission Guidelines

The University of Sydney has an internal timeline and application process for the NHMRC Postgraduate Scholarships in 2025. The instructions on how to submit your application for assessment are included in this document.

1) Timeline

- **9 April 2025** – Applications Open in Sapphire
- **5pm on 28 April 2025** – University of Sydney internal deadline for submission of Mandatory documents and Minimum data in Sapphire to be considered for **academic review**.
- **14 May 2025** – NHMRC deadline for Minimum data to be entered into Sapphire.
- **9am on 2 June 2025** – University of Sydney deadline for submission of Mandatory documents. If these documents are not submitted by the deadline your application may not be considered for submission to NHMRC by the University of Sydney.
- **9am 4 June 2025** Applicants must confirm they have made changes based on administrative feedback in Sapphire, certified and submitted their application in Sapphire.
- **5pm 4 June 2025** – Applications Close in Sapphire.

NOTE:

Mandatory Documents received by 9am 2 June

The University will complete administrative review by 5pm, 2 June. Applicants must confirm amendments have been made and certified and submitted their application in Sapphire by 9am 4 June.

If applicant's confirmation is not received by 9am 4 June, while all effort will be made, the University cannot guarantee that their application will be submitted

Mandatory Documents received after 9am 2 June

All effort will be made to provide administrative review. Administrative review is not guaranteed thus lead to application may be not submitted.

Regardless of when administrative review is issued to the applicant, the deadline for the applicant to confirm that amendment has been made, and certified and submitted their application in Sapphire remain as 9am 4 June.

If applicant's confirmation is not received by 9am 4 June, while all effort will be made, the University cannot guarantee that their application will be submitted.

Late Applications

Any new application and mandatory documents submitted after 12:00PM 4 June 2025 will not be endorsed by the University of Sydney

2) Commencing an Application

Before commencing an application, please ensure you determine that you are eligible for the NHMRC Postgraduate Research Scholarships and read all the application documents supplied by the NHMRC. These documents are available through Grant Connect. Grant Connect can be accessed at the below link.

3) Minimum Data

Once you have commenced an application in Sapphire, all minimum data fields must be completed by 14 May 2025. Failing to meet this deadline will result in the application not proceeding. Using placeholder text including in the **application title**, such as “text”, “synopsis” or “xx” may render your application ineligible by NHMRC. Minimum data fields for Postgraduate Scholarships are outlined in section 7.3 and Appendix C sections 3, 6.2 and 6.4 of the Postgraduate Scholarship 2025 Guidelines.

IMPORTANT: Ensuring compliance with minimum data requirements is the *sole responsibility of the applicant* and will not be included in any administrative or academic review that may be undertaken by the University. Applicants are advised to pay particular attention to the NHMRC guidelines for “application title.”

4) Mandatory Documents for Academic Review

If you submit minimum data in Sapphire and mandatory documents to the Scholarships Office by **5pm** on 28 April 2025 then your application may be considered for academic review*. If approved for academic review, an experienced academic will review your application and if necessary, would contact you directly with feedback and advise.

*Note that not all applications received by the deadline will be considered for academic review.

The following documents are required to be submitted to scholarships.office@sydney.edu.au in order to be considered for academic review:

- Proof of Citizenship or Permanent Residency
- Professional Registration Papers - these documents only need to be submitted if you are applying to receive the Priority Stipend as part of your application.
- Grant Proposal in Word version
- Curriculum Vitae (that includes a list of your publications)
- Application Summary, Application Report and Profile Report - these documents are generated from Sapphire.
- Authority to Submit Form - only needs to be signed by your Supervisor at this stage. If your application is approved by the University for submission to the NHMRC it will be signed by the Associate Dean (Research Education) and submitted to the Scholarships Office.

5) Mandatory Documents for submission to NHMRC

You must submit mandatory documents to the Scholarships Office by **9am** on 2 June 2025 to be considered for submission to NHMRC.

6) Eligibility

The Scholarships Office would conduct eligibility check for applications, as many as possible, and provide feedback to reduce the risk of being deemed ineligible by the NHMRC. Please be reminded that it is your responsibility to verify your circumstance against eligibility of the scholarship prior to applying in Sapphire. If you are a recipient of the Research Training Program (RTP) stipend scholarship, please email scholarships.office@sydney.edu.au for additional information.

7) Certifying your Application

If your mandatory documents are not submitted to Scholarships Office by **9am** on 2 June 2025 then your application may not be submitted to NHMRC by the University.

IMPORTANT: Provision of minimum data and mandatory documents by the required deadline does not guarantee that your application will be approved by the University for submission to the NHMRC.

You will be notified by the Scholarships Office if your application has been approved for you to commence the CI certification process in Sapphire.

Do not commence the CI certification process unless you have received approval from the University of Sydney Scholarships Office to do so.
