## **Rowan Nicks Russell Drysdale Fellowship in Australian Indigenous Health and Welfare 2021**

This **Fellowship** awards up to \$60,000 (negotiable depending on qualifications &/or experience) for a 12-month period.

The Fellowship is designed to support individuals wanting to make a contribution in the area of Australian Indigenous Health and Welfare. The Fellowship particularly aims to support workers and the development of future leaders in Australian Indigenous Health & Welfare.

**Australian Indigenous people are strongly encouraged to apply.**

Fellowships can take the form of:

- Funding for project work, consumables, administration costs etc and/or
- Salary/salaries for a 12-month period, whilst undertaking a project/program, at a level commensurate with the Fellow's experience and qualification OR
- A stipend and payment of course materials and/or fees to undertake approved education or research.

The Fellowship is open to Australian citizens who have appropriate prior experience, proof of community consultation and affirmation and/or education and wish to:

- **Undertake approved projects/programs/activities** OR
- **Undertake further education** OR
- **Undertake a research project**
