

Richard Copley Coltheart and David Copley Memorial Prize in Metaphysics

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. The Richard Copley Coltheart and David Copley Memorial Prize in Metaphysics is awarded to a student who achieves the highest mark in a unit of study at 2000-level or 3000-level in any subject area pertaining to metaphysics.
- b. Richard Copley Coltheart studied undergraduate philosophy at the University of Sydney, before commencing a PhD in the US. Sadly, he passed away before he could complete the degree. This Prize is funded by a donation from the Copley family.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Students must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree at the University of Sydney.
- b. Students must have completed a 2000-level or 3000-level unit of study pertaining to metaphysics in Philosophy.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded to the student who receives the highest mark in a 2000-level or 3000-level unit of study in any subject area pertaining to metaphysics.
- b. The prize will be awarded by the Chair of Philosophy or their nominee(s).

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value of \$500 and will be paid as a one-off payment.
- b. In the event multiple recipients are selected the value of the prize will be shared equally.
- c. No other amount is payable.
- d. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing Eligibility

a. None apply.
