

James Murdoch Prize for Japanese 4

1. Description

- a. The James Murdoch Prize for Japanese 4 is awarded to the best student in Junior Intermediate Japanese in the Department of Japanese at the University of Sydney.

2. Eligibility criteria

- a. To be eligible for this Prize, students must have completed JPNS 2612 Japanese 4 at the University of Sydney in the academic year for which the prize is offered.

3. Selection criteria

- a. This prize will be awarded to a high achieving student in Japanese 4, chosen at the discretion of the department.
- b. The prize will be awarded annually by the Chair of the Department of Japanese Studies at the University of Sydney.

4. Value

- a. The prize has a value of \$250 and will be paid as a one off payment.
- b. No other amount is payable.
- c. The prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing eligibility

- a. None apply.

6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
