

Kahneman / Thaler Prize

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

a. The Kahneman / Thaler Prize is named in honour of Nobel Laureates Daniel Kahneman and Richard Thaler to acknowledge excellence in the fields of business, psychology and/or economics.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be enrolled in an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework course at the University of Sydney.
- Applicants must submit a 1000-word essay addressing a topic in behavioural economics or psychology that influences government, NGO or corporate behaviour, as set by the Discipline of Strategy, Innovation and Entrepreneurship.

3. Selection Criteria

a. The Prize will be awarded by a selection committee consisting of academics from the Discipline of Strategy, Innovation & Entrepreneurship to the applicant with the best essay.

4. Value

a. This Prize has no monetary value.

5. Ongoing Eligibility

a. None apply.

6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.
