

Nemettallah and Kamle Habib Family Scholarship

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. This Scholarship was established in 1998 by the Habib family and is awarded to students studying the Doctor of Medicine who complete a research project in cardiovascular diseases and/or stroke.

2. Eligibility

- a. Applicants must be currently enrolled in the Doctor of Medicine in the University of Sydney School of Medicine (also known as Sydney Medical School).
- b. Applicants must have completed a research project in cardiovascular diseases and/or stroke.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of an MDWAM (assessments and MD Project) of sufficient merit.
- b. Preference will be given to a project focusing on both cardiovascular diseases and stroke.
- c. The Scholarship will be awarded by the Head of School and Dean of the Sydney Medical School, or their nominated delegate(s).

4. Value

- a. The Scholarship is valued at \$5,000 per annum and will be paid as a one-off payment
- b. The Scholarship will be offered subject to the availability of funds.
- c. No other amount is payable.

5. Ongoing eligibility

- a. Not applicable.

6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Scholarship, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Scholarship.
- b. Once withdrawn the Scholarship will not be reinstated.
