



Roderick and Janet West Prize

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. This Prize was established in 2017 from a donation by Joydeep Hor to commemorate Roderick West (1933-2016), an inspiring educator who was Headmaster of Trinity Grammar School 1975-1996, and his wife Janet West, who was a teacher and historian of Anglicanism and women in the Australian church.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Students must have completed at least one of the below units at the University of Sydney in the academic year for which the prize is offered:
 - I. GRKA1600 Introduction to Ancient Greek 1,
 - II. GRKA1601 Introduction to Ancient Greek 2,
 - III. GRKA2620 Learn to Read Ancient Greek 1,
 - IV. GRKA2621 Learn to Read Ancient Greek 2,
 - V. GRKA7001 Classical Greek for Postgraduates I,
 - VI. GRKA7002 Classical Greek for Postgraduates II,
 - VII. LATN1600 Introduction to Latin 1,
 - VIII. LATN1601 Introduction to Latin 2,
 - IX. LATN2620 Learn to Read Latin 1,
 - X. LATN2621 Learn to Read Latin 2,
 - XI. LATN7201 Latin for Postgraduates I, and
 - XII. LATN7020 Latin for Postgraduates I.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded based on academic merit.
- b. The prizes will be awarded annually by the Chair of Classics and Ancient History or their nominated delegate(s) at the University of Sydney.

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value of \$500 and will be paid as a one-off payment.
- b. The value of the prize may be shared if multiple students are of equal merit.
- c. No other amount is payable.
- d. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing Eligibility



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a. None apply.

6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.
