



H.M. Moran Prize

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. The H.M. Moran Prize is awarded for the best essay in the history of medicine and science by a catholic undergraduate student.
- b. This Prize is funded by a donation from Dr HM Moran.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Applicants must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree at the University of Sydney.
- b. Applicants must be catholic.
- c. Applicants must submit an essay (maximum of 5000 words) on the history of medicine and science that they have written.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded by a selection committee comprising:
 - I. an academic in History, School of Humanities, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences,
 - II. an academic in the Faculty of Medicine and Health, and
 - III. an academic in the Faculty of Science.

4. Value

- a. The value of this Prize will be determined each year based on the funding available. The exact value of the prize will be included on the Scholarships Office website at the time of advertising each year and outlined in the recipient(s) Offer Letter.
- b. The prize will be paid as a one-off payment.
- c. The value of the prize may be shared if more than one applicant is deemed of equal merit.
- d. No other amount is payable.
- e. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.

- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.

6. Publishing

- a. The recipient(s) of the prize must consent for the University to publish their prize submission at <https://ses.library.usyd.edu.au/> under both their name and Nom de Plume. This consent will be given by recipient(s) completing and returning the Copyright Release – Sydney eScholarship Repository Form to the Scholarships Office on acceptance of the prize.
