

The Judith Yates Essay Prize in Economics

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. The Judith Yates Essay Prize in Economics is awarded for the best annual essay exploring the topic of unmet societal needs.
- b. This Prize is funded by the University of Sydney USA Foundation.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Applicants must be one of the following:
 - I. enrolled in second or third year of the pre-Honours pathway in the Bachelor of Economics/Bachelor of Advanced Studies at the University of Sydney, or
 - II. enrolled in the fourth year of the Honours pathway in the Bachelor of Economics/Bachelor of Advanced Studies at the University of Sydney.
- b. Applicants must submit an essay on the advertised essay question.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded to the applicant who submitted the best essay.
- b. The prize will be awarded by a selection committee convened by the Head of School, School of Economics or their nominated delegate(s).

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value of \$10,000 and will be paid as a one off payment.
- b. No other amount is payable.
- c. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.
