



The Judith Yates Essay Prize in Economics

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. The Judith Yates Essay Prize in Economics ('the Prize') is awarded annually for the best essay exploring the topic of unmet societal needs.
- b. The Prize is funded by the University of Sydney USA Foundation.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Applicants must be:
 - I. enrolled in the second or third year of the pre-Honours pathway (Advanced Economics program) in one of the following courses:
 - Bachelor of Economics
 - Bachelor of Economics and Bachelor of Advanced Studies
 - Bachelor of Economics and Bachelor of Arts, or
 - Bachelor of Economics and Bachelor of Laws
 - or
 - II. enrolled in Honours (fourth year) in the Bachelor of Economics (Honours).
- b. Applicants must submit an essay on the advertised essay question.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded by a selection committee convened by the Head of School, School of Economics or their nominated delegate(s).
- b. The Prize will be awarded to the applicant who, in the opinion of the selection committee, submitted the best essay.

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value of \$10,000 and will be paid as a one-off payment.
- b. No other amount is payable.
- c. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.
