

The Ormsby Hamilton Prize

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

a. The Ormsby Hamilton Prize has been generously donated by J.W. Hamilton for the encouragement of the study of Radio Science.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. To be considered eligible for this Prize, students must either:
 - I. Have submitted an Honours thesis, through the School of Physics, at the University of Sydney in the previous calendar year,
 - II. Have had an HDR thesis accepted, through the School of Physics, at the University of Sydney in the previous calendar year.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prizes will be awarded based on students receiving one of the following:
 - i. best Honours thesis in Honours (Physics) in Radio Science.
 - ii. best HDR thesis in Radio Science.

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value of \$900 and will be paid as a one-off payment.
- b. This Prize is available for one recipient per cohort as defined in 2.a. and 3.a.
- c. In the event multiple recipients are selected per cohort, the value of the prize will be shared equally.
- d. No other amount is payable.
- e. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing Eligibility

a. None apply.

6. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.
