



University of Sydney Academic Merit Prize

Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. The University of Sydney Academic Merit Prize is awarded to students with academic excellence in their undergraduate degree.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Students must have:
 - I. been enrolled in an undergraduate degree in the relevant calendar year.
 - II. completed a minimum of 24 credit points in their undergraduate degree in the relevant calendar year.
 - III. achieved an annual average mark (AAM) in the relevant calendar year of at least 85.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded to eligible students with the highest AAM in their Faculty of enrolment in the relevant calendar year.
- b. Not all eligible students will be awarded with the prize due to limited funding being available.

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a maximum value of \$1,000 to students who have completed 48 credit points or more in their undergraduate degree in the relevant calendar year.
- b. The value of the prize will be pro-rated (rounded up to the nearest dollar) based on the number of credit points completed in the student's undergraduate degree in the relevant calendar year.
- c. No other amount is payable.
- d. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Termination

- a. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize, if the University determines that the student is guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize.
- b. Once withdrawn the Prize will not be reinstated unless due to University error.
