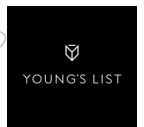

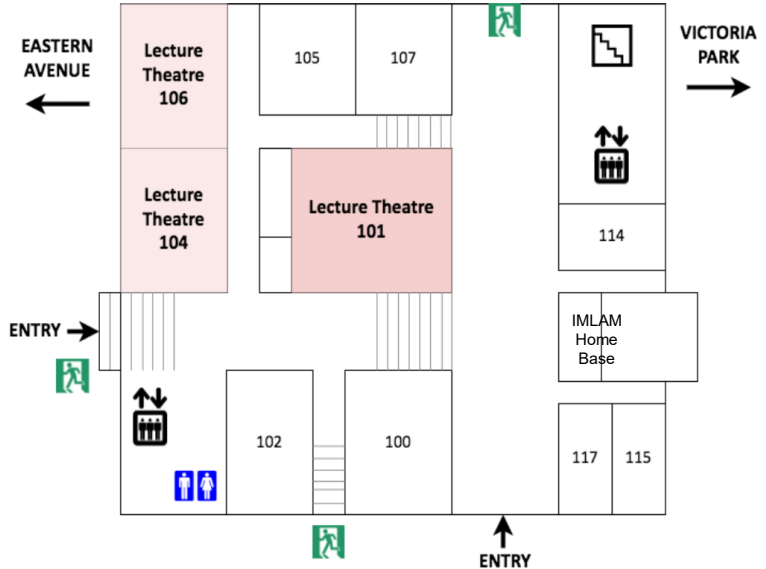
IMLAM 2025 Mooting Map/s

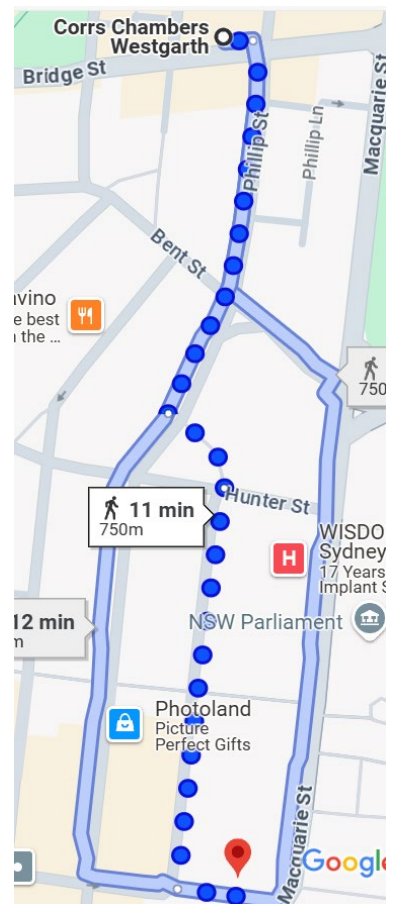

Getting around Sydney is easy with public transport, and most key venues are accessible by train, bus, or light rail. Below are directions to important locations for the IMLAM competition:

The University of Sydney

Located in Camperdown/Darlington, the main entrance is near **City Road** and **Victoria Park**.

- Closest train station: **Redfern Station** (10–15 min walk)
- Multiple buses run along **Parramatta Road** and **City Road** directly to campus. Bus Routes Include; **412, 413, 422, 423, 426, 428, 430, 440**

Sydney CBD

The central business district is easily accessible from the University by bus or train.

Things to do – Sydney

Sydney Opera House



An iconic symbol of Australia, the Sydney Opera House offers guided tours and world-class performances. Even if you don't catch a show, the harbour views from the steps are unforgettable and there is a restaurant outside of it.

Sydney Harbour Bridge



Walk across the harbour bridge. Whilst expensive, the BridgeClimb offers a thrilling ascent to the summit. Alternatively, The Sydney Harbour Bridge offers a fascinating history and heritage experience at the Pylon Lookout and Museum, located in the southeast pylon of the bridge.



Royal Botanical Gardens Sydney

Founded in 1816 on the site of Australia's first European farm, the Garden is a historic oasis of native and exotic plants along Sydney Harbour. Visitors can enjoy scenic walks, themed gardens, and insights into Aboriginal and colonial history.



Ferry to Manly

Take a scenic ferry ride from Circular Quay to Manly Beach. Once there, enjoy the surf, explore coastal walks, or grab fish and chips by the water.



Tarango Zoo

Set on the harbour, Taronga Zoo is home to native and exotic animals with a view. Don't miss the Sky Safari cable car or the daily animal encounters.



Sydney Tower Eye

Head to the top of Sydney's tallest building for 360-degree views of the city. Within the building are restaurants and shopping stores.



Cockatoo Island

A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Cockatoo Island blends convict history with industrial heritage. Opportunity to Explore the tunnels or do a tour. Visiting open from 10am – 4pm.

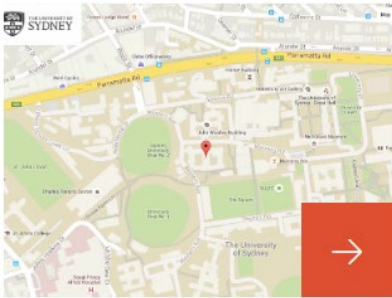
