



SSEAC HONOURS BURSARY 2021 GUIDELINES

The SSEAC Honours Bursary 2021 is for commencing or continuing students intending to enrol in an Honours program at the University of Sydney in 2021, whose research will relate to one or more Southeast Asian country. Up to ten scholarships worth \$2000 each will be awarded.

For the purposes of the grant, Southeast Asia is defined as Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Timor-Leste and Vietnam.

ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS

To be eligible applicants must:

- apply for entry to the University of Sydney commencing in 2021.
- enrol in an Honours program at the University of Sydney, which must involve an additional year to a standard undergraduate degree.
- be researching a topic related to one or more Southeast Asian country.
- have a distinction average during their undergraduate studies.
- be either a local student (an Australian or New Zealand citizen, or permanent resident of Australia) or an international student who has completed an undergraduate degree at the University of Sydney.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD

The following criteria will be taken into consideration by the SSEAC Grants Subcommittee when assessing the applications:

- The quality and feasibility of the research proposal
- Level of support from supervisors

In cases where scheme requirements are not fully met following an award the awardees and the nominated supervisor will be ineligible to apply for any future financial support from SSEAC.
