

EMERITUS PROFESSOR ANN ELIZABETH SEFTON AO – FORMER DEPUTY CHANCELLOR (2004–08) AND PRO-CHANCELLOR (2003)

Emeritus Professor Ann Sefton AO was a Fellow of Senate elected by and from the graduates of the University of Sydney for two terms from 1 December 2001 to 30 November 2009. During this period, Ann was appointed Pro-Chancellor (2003) and was elected Deputy Chancellor by Senate for two terms, from 20 February 2004 to 4 February 2008.

While Deputy Chancellor, Ann presided over a number of graduation ceremonies including overseas graduations, and was:

- Chair of the Ad Hoc Advisory Committee for the Selection of Chancellor
- Chair of the Advisory Committee for Honorary Awards
- Acting Chair of the Chair Appointments Committee
- an ex-officio member of most Senate committees
- an ex-officio member of the Law Extension Committee.

As a graduate Fellow of Senate, Ann was a member of the Alumni Council from 2006 to 2009.
