Terms and Conditions

1. Background

- a. The Keith & Eileen Ong Research Project Prize was established in 2024 and is awarded to students achieved the highest grade for the Doctor of Medicine (MD) project.
- b. This Prize is donated by Dr Keith & Dr Eileen Ong.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- a. Applicants must be currently enrolled full-time in Year 3 or Year 4 of the Doctor of Medicine (MD) at the University of Sydney.
- b. Applicants must have completed or be in the process of completing the MD research project as part of their course requirements.

3. Selection Criteria

- a. The Prize will be awarded to students with the highest grade for the MD project, consisting of:
 - I. essay mark, and
 - II. examination mark.
- b. The Prize will be awarded by the Head of School and Dean, School of Medicine, University of Sydney, or their nominated delegate(s).

4. Value

- a. This Prize has a value of \$5000 and will be paid as a one-off payment.
- b. If more than one student is of equal merit, the value of the prize will be equally shared.
- c. No other amount is payable.
- d. The Prize will be awarded subject to the availability of funds.

5. Ongoing Eligibility

- a. None apply.
