COVID safety in classes

Semester 1 classes will begin on Monday 21 February for most courses, with <u>COVID</u> <u>safety precautions in place</u>. If you're attending classes on campus, make sure you follow our conditions of entry, wear a mask indoors, and if you're feeling sick or have COVID symptoms, stay home, get tested and let your unit coordinator know.

NSW Health pop-up vaccination clinic on campus

From 9am to 4pm on Thursday 17 and Friday 18 February there will be a <u>pop-up vaccination clinic</u> at MacLaurin Hall. No booking required, just walk in on the day. Boosters are available for those aged 16 and over if it has been at least three months since your second dose. A Medicare card is not required, but if you have one, please bring it with you.

- If you're a new student, make sure you complete the <u>Academic Honesty</u> and <u>Consent</u> <u>Matters</u> education modules by Tuesday 31 March.
- The new <u>Student Academic Appeals Rule 2021</u> has replaced the Student Appeals Against Academic Decisions Rule 2006 to provide more clarity and transparency around academic decisions and appeal processes. The previous Rule will continue to apply to any appeals lodged prior to 10 January 2022.
- If you intend to study in Semester 1, submit your re-enrolment by 18 February. Some
 courses may have a different deadline so <u>check the faculty or school variations</u>. For
 information about study arrangements in Semester 1 2022, <u>visit the COVID website</u>.
