

Application for Concurrent Enrolment - Combined Law

Combined Law students must complete the requirements of their first degree before transferring to the Bachelor of Laws to complete their final two years of law. However, at the discretion of the Law School, students who are due to transfer to the Bachelor of Laws but still have a limited number of units to complete in their first degree may be eligible to concurrently enrol in both their first degree and the Bachelor of Laws.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for concurrent enrolment:

- you should be due to commence your penultimate law year but you are behind in your first degree; AND
- you have less than 24cp remaining in your first degree; AND
- you have completed at least eight out of the ten LAWS1000 level units which are part of your first degree.

Note: concurrent enrolment applications are considered on a case-by-case basis and eligibility to apply does not guarantee approval.

Conditions of Concurrent Enrolment

- Concurrent enrolment is normally approved for one semester only but may be extended to two semesters if you cannot satisfy requirements of your first degree within the one semester (eg you cannot satisfy your major).
- Concurrent enrolment is not permitted for more than two semesters in total.
- You are not permitted to undertake more than 24cp in any semester in which you are concurrently enrolled.
