

Severe weather warning

Dear students.

A severe weather warning has been issued for most of NSW's east coast including Greater Sydney for tomorrow, Wednesday 2 March. Due to these weather conditions, a number of areas across Sydney may be flooded and/or inaccessible, and travel services may be disrupted.

Some in-person classes may be switched from in-person to remote classes temporarily or changed to alternative locations on campus. Any changes will be communicated via your Unit of Study coordinator – please check <u>Canvas</u> for any updates.

As you will have seen, areas of northern NSW and southeast Queensland have experienced record flooding over the last few days with many areas needing to be evacuated. Members of our community based at the University Centre for Rural Health in Lismore are being supported. If you need to come to campus, please take care. Please contact 1800 SYD HLP (1800 793 457) if you are in any difficulty or notice any flooding or damage to University property.
