

## Updated Bachelor of Advanced Studies information

Dear students.

I wanted to let you know the University has agreed on an approach to address the administrative issue regarding our Bachelor of Advanced Studies degrees that I wrote to you about on Friday 16 February.

I'd like to reassure you that your enrolment, unit of study selections and timetables remain unaffected and Bachelor of Advanced Studies students do not need to do anything at this time.

We'll now be making some administrative changes to the Bachelor of Advanced Studies to ensure graduates are awarded degree certificates that clearly show they've fulfilled the requirements of two degrees. Those who complete a four-year Bachelor of Advanced Studies combined degree will receive either:

- · two level 7 Bachelor degrees or,
- a level 7 Bachelor degree and a level 8 Bachelor (Honours) degree, for those who have fulfilled the requirements of honours.

We'll be working through this administrative process as quickly as possible and will keep affected students updated. Information is available on <u>our website</u>.

Students enrolled in other degrees are not affected in any way.
