Dear students.

Today the flags at the University Quadrangle are flying at half-mast in memory of our student and the other victims of the terrible Bondi Junction tragedy. In the face of such a senseless loss, coming together to mourn as a community can provide some comfort. From this afternoon, Monday 15 April, through to Saturday 20 April, the grassed area at the front of the Quadrangle near the Great Hall will be a space for people to commemorate the lives lost.

All members of our extended community, including students of other universities and local residents, are welcome to come here and place flowers and small cards in memory of our student who has died. The family of our student has asked that no identifying messages or photos be placed at the memorial, and we sincerely ask that this wish be respected.
