Some of you may be aware that earlier today some buildings at our Camperdown/Darlington campus were temporarily evacuated, including Fisher Library and the New Law Building. This precaution was part of a NSW Police operation, and the Police have informed us that they have completed their work, and these areas are now accessible as normal.
