The University has been advised that additional protest activity, including a rally, is likely on our Camperdown/Darlington campus today. There may be some disruption and Eastern Avenue may be crowded and noisy from 9:30 am to 12 pm as a result of this activity. If you are planning to come to campus, you may wish to consider avoiding the area during this time.

Consistent with our long-standing commitment to academic freedom and freedom of expression, the University supports the right of our students and staff to assemble and protest peacefully.

Equally, we have zero tolerance for any form of racism, threats to safety, hate speech, intimidation, threatening speech, bullying or unlawful harassment, including antisemitic or anti-Muslim language or behaviour.
