We are aware of media coverage that the bodies of two individuals found in Burwood yesterday are being reported as University of Sydney students.

We are cooperating closely with the police, who have advised that the identities of the individuals have not yet been formally confirmed. The police investigation is ongoing, and the information I can share with you at this time is limited for that reason.

This is unsettling news for our community. I encourage you to reach out for support if you need it.
