Vice-Chancellor Michael Spence farewells Sydney

After 12 years at the University of Sydney, Dr Michael Spence AC will soon end his term as Vice-Chancellor and Principal for a new position at UCL in London. At a farewell event last month Dr Spence reflected on his time at Sydney and what he sees in the future of the role of the institution.



"It has been my great joy to lead the University of Sydney these past twelve years. It is a marvellous place. It is not the tame, biddable producer of useful ideas and neatly skilled pliant graduates for which so many politicians might hope. It is a roaring lion of a place... Long may it continue to be so, for the benefit of Sydney, Australia and the wider world."

Results and re-enrolment in 2021

January and February intensives

You will need to have received all of your results and been invited to re-enrol before you can select a unit in a January or February intensive session. Please note the deadline for the last day to add a unit of study in a January 2021 intensive is 8 January. The deadline for the last day to add a unit of study in a February 2021 intensive is 20 January. Find out more about enrolling in intensive units.
