- Access to a number of buildings across campus has changed to allow easier access to teaching rooms and study spaces in the first few weeks of Semester 1.
- Enrolment closes this Friday 26 February. Where possible, select units of study that don't require you to submit an <u>enrolment exception request</u>. You can cancel or withdraw your request, so you can select other units and complete your enrolment. If you need to submit a request to enrol in your course, these requests will be prioritised but you'll need to make sure you meet the <u>eligibility requirements</u> and can provide any necessary supporting information. You will not be able to complete enrolment until you've submitted your request and it's been processed.

setup MFA today by following the instructions to set up MFA using Okta Verify as the
primary authenticator.
