COVID-19 update

The NSW Premier has announced today that current stay-at-home orders in Greater Sydney will be extended until Saturday 28 August. Please monitor the NSW Health website for other restriction changes, and continue to check our COVID-19 website for University updates.

The University is preparing to deliver the first four weeks of Semester 2 remotely. Please note you do not need to change your enrolment to RE (remote), particularly if you want to return to inperson classes when restrictions ease. You should select, or remain, in the on campus 'CC' units if you want to return to campus at any point.

If you intend to study remotely for the whole semester, you will need to make sure you select units where the location code is 'RE', meaning Remote.




