Remote learning may not be for everyone but it still has its moments. Sharing your experience over social media is a great way to connect with the **#usydonline** community.





Applications open for general bursaries and Financial Assistance Vouchers

General bursaries of \$1,000 are available to all enrolled students (including Australian citizens, Australian permanent residents and international citizens) who meet eligibility criteria. International students located in Australia who meet the criteria but cannot demonstrate an interruption to employment due to COVID-19 may be eligible for International Student Financial Assistance Vouchers.
