Extension of remote learning and support available

The Vice-Chancellor has written to all students about continuing arrangements for Semester 2.


Key points:

- The majority of classes will continue to be delivered remotely until at least 27 September (the start of mid-semester break).
- The library and some study hubs remain open, with modified opening hours, for activities that you cannot undertake from home. Please stay home if at all possible, but if you do need to come in, make sure that you follow all of our COVID-safe procedures.
- If you are a student living in Australia experiencing genuine and immediate financial hardship, financial support is available, in the form of bursaries for all students and food vouchers for international students. Please visit our student website for more information and details of how to access this support.
- Visit our page on COVID-19 vaccinations to find out information about the COVID-19 vaccines, as well as where our staff and students can access the vaccine.
