Library opening hours extended

As vaccination rates across NSW continue to rise, the University is starting to return to normal operations. As the first step, and to support students during STUVAC and end of semester exams, the Library will extend its opening hours from Monday 15 November.

- The University is planning to re-open Fisher and Law libraries to staff and students, from 9am to midnight, 7 days a week.
- From Wednesday 17 November the Carslaw Learning Hub will also extend to 24/7 access for staff and students.

More details about these arrangements will be provided shortly, including any entry requirements and COVID-safe protocols, so please make sure to check your University email and our website regularly for updates.

Co-curricular Grants Program makes student ideas a reality

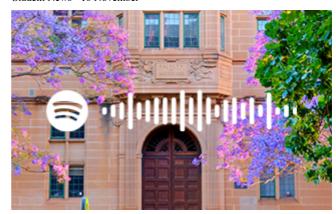

Your safety is important

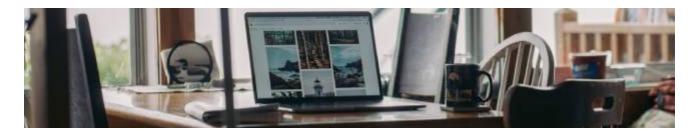
