Update on Semester 2 classes

The Vice-Chancellor has today emailed all students to provide an update on Semester 2 teaching arrangements.

- For Semester 2, 2022 the University plans to continue with the hybrid model that has seen most students returning to campus for a component of the majority of their courses, with remote options available where possible for those who require them.
- A small number of units of study will require an approval process for students to enrol in the remote option. More information will be communicated to students enrolling in these units.
- We are mindful of the ongoing challenges our offshore students face in returning to Australia
 and we will continue to support you with remote learning options in Semester 2, wherever
 possible.
