Applications open for advertised bursaries

Advertised bursaries are mini scholarships that support specific cohorts of domestic students in financial need. For example, you may be eligible if you are a first-year student, are registered with Inclusion and Disability Services, identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander, or if you are enrolled in a particular faculty. Bursaries range from \$500 to \$6000. Applications close Friday 30 September. For any questions, reach out to the Office of Student Life via the financial support enquiry form.

Disability support for formal examinations


If you have a disability or medical condition (temporary or ongoing) which may disadvantage you in your formal examinations, you may be able to access reasonable adjustments through Inclusion and Disability Services (IDS). To be approved for adjustments in your Semester 2 formal exams, you will need to register with IDS and book a consultation appointment with an Inclusion and Disability Officer before Wednesday 5 October.
